**Show Schedule:** Saturday: Show opens at 9:00 am for benching fish for the show. All fish should be benched no later than 12:00 pm. \$1 per entry for show, but is waived for mail-ins. Please bring your own bowls (2 ½ gal. limit), treated water available. Box sales will begin at 9:00 am and continue throughout the day. \$.50 per item collected upon seller's arrival, with a refund on all unsold items. Judging is at 4:00 pm, followed by the dinner and awards ceremony at 6:00 pm. Dinner, coffee and soft drinks will be furnished for free, with a cash bar. Sunday: Auction will begin at 12:00 pm. Auction registration is from 9:00 am to 12:00 pm. Auction split is 70/30 in favor of the seller.
